The deadline for all bills to pass their house of origin was June 4. Those that did not pass have a second opportunity early next year. These are listed below.

Bills that passed their first house now begin the committee hearing process in the second house.

## LEGISLATIVE BRIEFS - A CLOSER LOOK...

Bills we are tracking are now in their second house, so you will be contacting assembly members for Senate bills and senators for Assembly bills.

**SR 39 | HR 51 - Resolutions supporting Pride Month.** Includes a statement in support of the Equality Act: in the U.S. Congress: H.R. 5; S. 393.

**ACTION:** Contact lawmakers to oppose.

**SB245- Essentially makes all abortions free. Hearing Date on June 22nd.**

Prohibits deductibles, co-pays, etc. - in other words, abortions must be free.

**ACTION:** Contact lawmakers to oppose. Call into the hearing to voice your opposition (View the video: "[How to Lobby from your Kitchen Table](#)").

**SB380 - Assisted Suicide. Hearing Date on June 22nd.** Shortens from 15 days to 2 days the "cooling off" period before lethal drugs can be prescribed.

**ACTION:** Contact lawmakers to oppose. Call into the hearing to voice your opposition (View the video below: "How to Lobby from Your Kitchen Table").

**ACTION:** Hearing postponed. Use this time to contact members of the committee and even your own state senator to share your concerns.

Committee hearings are open to the public via telephone, allowing citizens to call in and voice support or opposition for bills being heard.

Last year, Assembly Bill 33, proposing to make ethnic studies a high-school graduation requirement, thankfully died. This year, as Calif. AB 101, it has been resurrected and is very much alive.

The good news: The vote on this bill is presently postponed. Notwithstanding that, if it passes, whose ethnic worldview will students meet in the classroom - one that lauds cultural distinctions such as styles of dress, ethnic foods, and customs; or lessons set to pit people groups against each other as either oppressors of others or those who are the oppressed?

## Letter to the Governor: Explanation Demanded for Ongoing state of Emergency

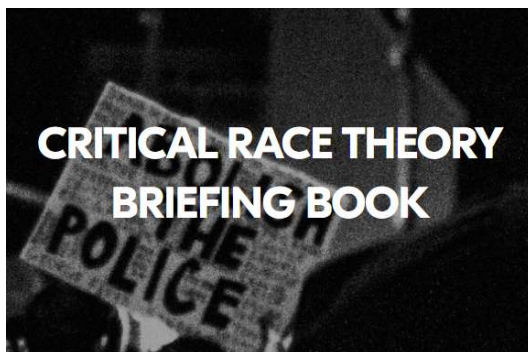

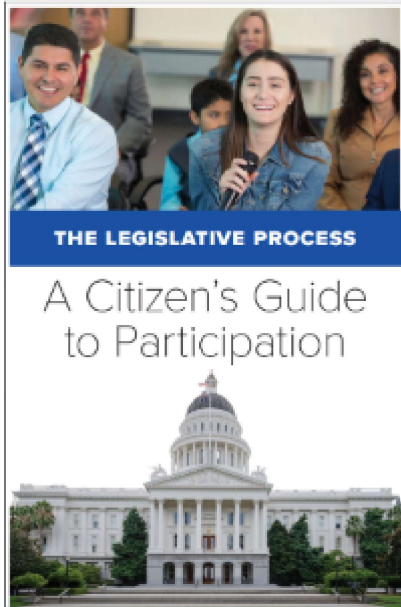
## DEFINITION

**June 7** Committee meetings may resume (J.R. 61(a)(9)).

**June 15** Budget Bill must be passed by midnight (Art. IV, Sec. 12(c)(3)).
