Judeo-Christian Caucus Commentary The Sad Tale of Two (Legislative) Bills...



Senate Bill 217 (Dahle), died in the Appropriations Committee this month. The bill required school districts to be transparent with regard to the sexual health education curriculum they are using. This is

another blow to parental rights and further confirmation to not only opt children out of these classes, but to <u>exit the public-school system</u> entirely. Think about it. Parents are denied the right to know what their own children learn in school.

Another bill, <u>Senate Bill 397</u> (Jones), would have deemed religious services "to be allowed, at the very least, to the same extent other essential services are permitted to operate." The Judeo-Christian Caucus, fighting for the citizens of California, was a <u>proud co-sponsor of SB 397</u>.

As with SB 217, the powers-that-be allowed SB 397 to pass through the Senate Education Committee, but killed it in Appropriations. Pity. Brave pastors and congregations fought really hard throughout COVID to preserve your right to worship freely.

The Judeo-Christian Caucus targets and posts bills not for curiosity's sake - and so many of them are very curious - but for the legislative action every biblical citizen can take.

When we support Judeo-Christian values and legislation from our Judeo-Christian Caucus legislators, we are supporting each other. The tale of two bills did not end well, but there will be more tales to tell.

The <u>full and final</u> <u>settlement</u> was approved in the District Court and thus is the first state-wide permanent injunction in the country against COVID restrictions on churches and places of worship. 



Supporting or opposing a bill usually means phoning, writing and, perhaps, visiting your legislator or his/her staff. Can you do more to help get your bill through the Legislature? You can attend hearings and testify on the bill.

Ask your legislator which policy committee your bill has been assigned to. The bill will be analyzed by a committee consultant prior to its hearing. (The analysis includes current law, what the bill does, background information and raises any questions the consultant may have about the bill.) Typically the analysis also includes support and opposition to the bill. Send a letter in support of your bill to the committee. Keep Reading...
